

CLINICAL ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (PER DIEM)

The Department of Obstetrics, Gynecology and Reproductive Health at Rutgers – New Jersey Medical School has **three** (3) per diem positions available at the Clinical Assistant Professor level, for Board Certified or Board Eligible Physicians, in the Division of General Obstetrics and Gynecology.

These three per diem positions will assist with week day and weekend L&D and in house urgent coverage with backup (up to 6 calls/month) at University Hospital. Candidates will also participate in the education of medical students, residents and fellows. The University Hospital, a primary teaching hospital of the Rutgers New Jersey Medical School, is a widely recognized tertiary care center and Level 1 Trauma Center.

New Jersey's academic health center, Rutgers Biomedical and Health Sciences (RBHS) takes an integrated approach to educating students, providing clinical care, and conducting research, all with the goal of improving human health. This position is at Rutgers- New Jersey Medical School (NJMS) in Newark, NJ. Aligned with Rutgers University–New Brunswick and collaborating university-wide, RBHS includes eight schools, a behavioral health network, and five centers and institutes that focus on cancer treatment and research, neuroscience, advanced biotechnology and medicine, environmental and occupational health, and health care policy and aging research. RBHS has recently agreed to a public/private partnership with RWJBarnabas Health, which will broaden the scope and reach to all New Jerseyans.

QUALFICATIONS include New Jersey Medical License and Board Eligible or Board Certification in Obstetrics and Gynecology.
