AMGO's Circle of Excellence was established to recognize leadership and excellence among AMGO members in our profession. This memo signifies that we are getting close to our annual meeting time. Please take a few minutes to record your participation in activities toward your eligibility for the Circle of Excellence. Entry into the Circle of Excellence is obtained once a member has a total accumulation of 50 points.

The form to use for calculating your points is available in this edition of the AMGO Newsletter [Annual COE Points Form](#). Members are to begin calculating points immediately following each annual meeting with the change in board and committee appointments and continue to calculate points through the next annual meeting. This year's points should be calculated through the annual meeting of 2010 *with the exception of "Attendance at AMGO Annual Meeting" which is to be utilized by those who attended the 2009 meeting held in Toronto, Canada.* Members who meet the 50-point criteria, and with Board approval, will be announced at the 2010 annual meeting. Those members already inducted in the COE who reach the next level of 50 points will also be recognized.

As you can see, no time limit has been set

for entry into the Circle of Excellence. Active participation within the organization will determine the time frame in which you meet the goal of 50 points. If you would like to know your total points accumulated to date, please contact Beth Owens as noted below. The Circle of Excellence will recognize those who work hard for the organization, encourage others to actively participate, and promote excellence within the organization. Please take time to complete your calculation form and return it to me as soon as possible.
